



Year 2 Curriculum Newsletter – Summer 2

Maths

In Maths, we will be revising making numbers to 100 and the place value system. We will continue to practice our arithmetic skills using all four operations ($-$, $+$, \times , \div). We will also be studying position and direction where the children will be describing movements (left and right) and turns (clockwise and anticlockwise). We will recap important knowledge of time and fractions to prepare the children for year 3.

English

During this term, we will be looking at a story called the Tin Forest. The children will be retelling the story in their own way to design a dream location using adjectives and conjunctions. We will also be studying Shakespeare this year, looking at The Tempest Play. The children will write a diary in the role of Ferdinand.

Science

In Science, this term, we will be looking at life cycles. They will be learning about how a caterpillar changes into a butterfly. Each class will have its own set of butterflies to study. The children will be learning key vocabulary to describe the changes in an animal's life cycle.

Art / DT

This term we will be looking at sewing a pouch.

History

We will be learning about Thomas Cook and the first holidays.

PE

Children will be taking part in outdoor games starting to develop their racket skills. They will also compete in athletics.

PHSE

This term's unit is called 'How changes makes us feel?'

RE

This term we will be looking at the Christians view of God.

Music

This term's music lessons will be looking at playing an instrument.
