

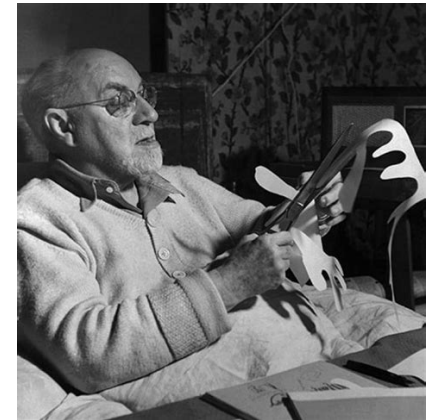

HENRI MATISSE IS ONE OF THE MOST FAMOUS ARTISTS IN THE WORLD. HE NOT ONLY PAINTED WITH BRUSHES BUT HE ALSO MADE PICTURES FROM CUT-OUT PAPER AND CALLED IT 'PAINTING WITH SCISSORS'. THE COMPOSITIONS WERE SOMETIMES ABSTRACT, BUT THE SHAPES REMIND US OF THINGS LIKE PLANTS, PEOPLE, LANDSCAPES AND ANIMALS. HERE I'VE CREATED A CUT PAPER UNDERWATER LANDSCAPE. THE SHAPES AT FIRST LOOK ABSTRACT, BUT ON CLOSER INSPECTION ARE A BIT LIKE FISH AND PLANTS YOU MIGHT FIND UNDER THE SEA.
