

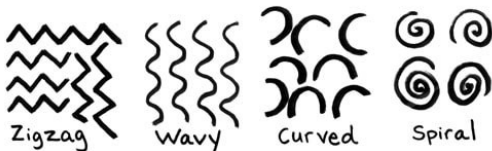
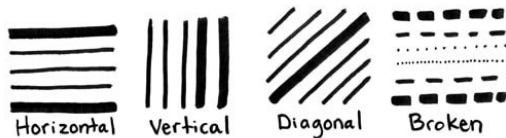


What do we mean by shape, line and tone?

Area of art: Drawing

Word	Definition
2D shapes	A flat area with edges.
lines	Lines can be used to create shapes, space or patterns.
tone	How light or dark a colour is.
Mark-making	The different lines, dots, marks and patterns made in art.
Pattern	A repeated decorative design.

Mark-making is created by drawing different lines, shapes and patterns.



Key Knowledge and Concepts

Artist: Nancy McCroskey

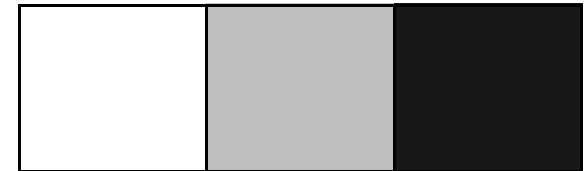
Nancy McCroskey is an American artist who repeats patterns, shapes and colours in her work. She is inspired by the patterns, lines, tones and shapes found in flowers, animals, maps and letters.

Skills: Lines, shapes and tones

To create different lines, you can use a range materials, such as pencils and coloured crayons.

Using lines, you can learn how to draw 2D shapes– some have straight lines, others have curved lines.

Tone is used in drawings to make objects look lighter or darker.

As a class, create your own version of Nancy McCroskey’s work. Explore the patterns in nature to inspire your work. Then in your square, include the shapes, lines and colours that inspire you. You could use curved lines, diagonal lines,
