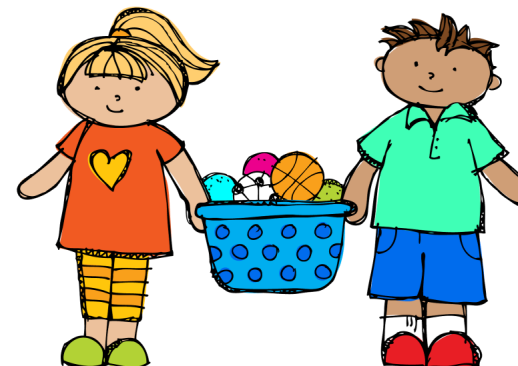


## Why do we have rules?
