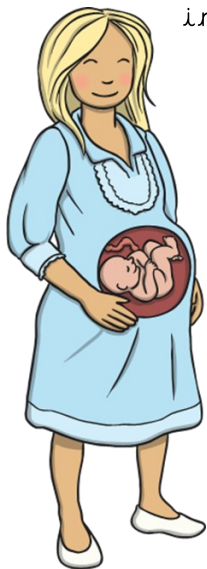
Key Knowledge and Concepts

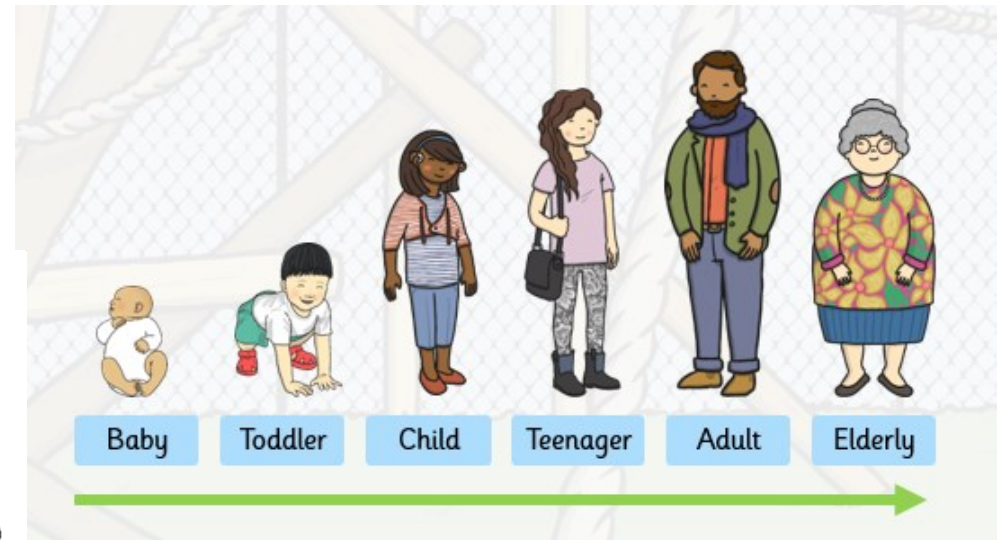
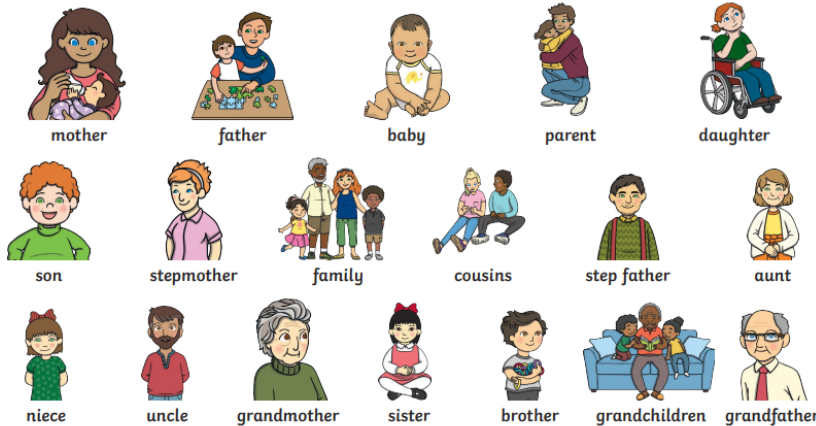
Your parents no longer need to be with you all the time, but still need to make sure that you are safe and happy.
