

What does it mean to be grown up?

Word	Definition
birth	Being born
adolescent	A person who is changing from a child to an adult; often called a teenager
adult	A grown up
middle age	The period of human life between youth and old age, or the years between forty and sixty-five
old age	The final stage of life, considered in humans to begin at about age sixty-five. Sometimes there is a decline in health
death	The end of life
responsibility	Responsibility means being dependable, making good choices, and taking accountability for your actions
Reproduce	To make a copy of themselves
Female egg	This is produced on average one a month from the ovaries
Male sperm	Sperm are the male reproductive cells

Key Knowledge and Concepts

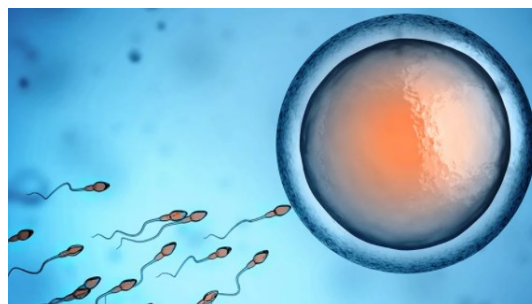
The human life cycle: birth, baby, child, adolescent/ teenager, adult, middle age, old age and death.

Bodies are different at different ages – give some examples: a baby cannot walk, an adolescent girl will develop breasts.

When animals reproduce they make a copy of themselves.

Human babies are made when an egg and sperm join together.

Grown-ups' responsibilities', include: paying bills, going to work, looking after children, looking after older relatives.



Children's responsibilities', include: going to school, looking after our belongings'.
