








Why would I need to join fabrics together?

Word	Definition	
Sew	Join together using thread.	
Fabric	Cloth or other material made by weaving or knitting fibres.	
Needle	Used to pull thread to join things together.	
Knot	A way of locking the stitches from coming undone.	
Pouch	A small bag made to keep things safe and be easily carried.	

Key Knowledge and Concepts

Sewing - Can be hand sewing or machine sewing.



Fabric - Can be natural or man-made, woven or knitted. Made from plant fibres, animal fur or synthetic materials.



Eye of a needle - A hole in the needle to put the thread through.

Running stitch - A simple straight line, no overlapping.



Template - Helps to draw the same shape easily on different materials.

Accurate - Cutting and sewing needs to be neat, the correct size and shape.

Pin - Similar to a needle, but has no eye. Used to hold the fabric together, ready to sew it.

- Skirt, Trousers
- Rucksack,

- T-shirts
