



# When would you use a blanket stitch?

Word	Definition
<b>Blanket-stitch</b>	A decorative stitch that securely joins two pieces of fabric together.
<b>Stuffed toy</b>	Two pieces of fabric sewn together and filled with flexible material. Sometimes called plush toys.
<b>Hand-made</b>	Something made by hand, not by a machine.
<b>Threading</b>	To pass one end of a thread through (for example) the eye of a needle.
<b>Stuffing</b>	Soft material used to fill soft furnishings eg cushions and toys.
<b>Appendage</b>	Something attached to a larger more important part.
<b>Annotate</b>	Add notes to explain a plan or design.
<b>Quality</b>	How good or bad something is. The quality of something can range from excellent to low.
<b>Detail</b>	The small features of an object.

## Key Knowledge and Concepts.

**Blanket-stitch** - Is also used to reinforce the edge of a fabric material, as well as to join two pieces of fabric together.

**Safety** - To stay safe when sewing, you must be careful when threading the needle through the fabric.
