Timeline

Welcome Pack

You should receive this pack around 16th April.

Stay and Play Days

Your child will be given a date where they can come with you into our nursery and play with the toys to get them used to our setting.

Start Date

We will give your child a start date.

Home Visits

We will come and see you at home between 27th August and 6th September.

Paperwork Deadline

All of the paperwork within this pack must be returned to us by 6th September.



Important Information

The School Day

School starts at 8:30am.

School finishes at 11:30am.

Uniform

- Blue jumper/cardigan, plain or with the school logo. If you would like one with a school logo they can be purchased from our supplier (there is a leaflet included in your pack)
- Grey/black trousers or skirt
- Blue gingham summer dress
- Black shoes, preferably velcro not laces



P.E Kit

- P.E will be on a Monday
- Children should come in their PE kit on this day
- White t-shirt
- Black joggers or shorts
- Trainers/plimsols
- No jewelry, earrings must be removed or taped.

Water Bottles

Please send your child to school with a labelled water bottle everyday.

Milk and Fruit

Children will be offered milk and a piece of fruit everyday. Milk is free up to the age of 5 but you must apply for it. There is a leaflet included in your pack on how to do this.

Book Bags

Your child will be given a free book bag when they start with us.
